

Speaker A/V Needs and Other Notes

Slides

Dallin usually presents with a PowerPoint slide deck that includes sound. If your setup does not accommodate embedded sound, please reach out to make custom arrangements. He will arrive at the event site at least an hour early on the day of the event and provide his presentation file to the A/V team. Since Dallin tailors programs specifically for the event, including occasionally updating slides as the event progresses, slides are typically not sent ahead of time.

Stage

Dallin does not use a podium. If the venue has a podium, it should be moved as far out of the way as possible. If Dallin is presenting "The Secret To Conflict-Free Communication", there should be two chairs placed next to each other, side by side, in the center of the stage. Dallin will walk around and use the entire stage, and for most presentations will either walk into the audience or have volunteers join him on stage.

Microphone

Dallin does not travel with a microphone, so please ensure one is provided. Countrymen mics are preferred, followed by lavalier/lapel mics, then handheld microphones. Handheld microphones do not work for dance-related presentations.

Music

The track should be played in it's entirety, and already has a fade-out built into it.

Tech Check

Dallin will plan to arrive at least an hour before the presentation time for a tech/sound check, but can arrive earlier if necessary.
